

Summer Reading Challenge Terms and Conditions

HOW TO ENTER:

- 1. Registered participants of the Summer Reading Challenge will be eligible to receive incentive prizes and to go into a draw for a final prize. Registrations are online via the library website https://www.library.camden.nsw.gov.au/events/summer-reading-challenge. Registration commences on 9 December 2024.
- 2. Once registered, attend Camden, Narellan or Oran Park Libraries to collect your reading log bookmark for children 0-11 years of age, or bingo card for youth aged 12+. Adult
- 3. Reading Log Bookmark Each day, read for 15 minutes and mark your bookmark. Once the bookmark is completed return to the library to receive a brag tag.
- 4. Bingo card for each book, mark off on your bingo card. Bingo can be achieved by completing a row, a column, or a diagonal on the card.

PRIZES:

Participants 0-11 years of age:

All completed reading challenge bookmarks returned to the libraries will receive a brag tag and will go into the draw to receive a family movie pass.

Participants 12-17:

Achieve 4 reading bingo challenges to receive 1x swimming gift voucher for Oran Park Leisure Centre and go into the draw for a family movie pass. Each book marked off in a row, a column, or a diagonal on the bingo card, will receive 1 x chocolate bar to be collected from either Camden, Narellan or Oran Park Libraries.

Participants 18+:

Complete all the quests in the tarot card pack to receive a \$10 book voucher and go into the draw for a family movie pass.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all ages 0+.

> Entrants must reside in the Camden Local Government Area or attend school in the Camden Local Government Area. All entrants must be a registered Library member of Camden Council Libraries

Camden Council employees, volunteers, contractors, consultants, Committee members, their families and household members are ineligible to enter.
