





# **Guidelines and disclaimer**

To be considered to take part in Council's Artist of the Month Exhibition Program, you are required to apply through Council's Library website. Please provide all necessary information.

## Eligibility

You need to live, work or study in the Camden Local Government Area or Macarthur Region.

### **Artist Responsibility**

Artists are responsible for the delivery, installation, hanging and pick up of all works.

#### Artwork

- All artworks are to be suitably framed for hanging, framed with D-hooks preferably and wire. All gallery spaces have the same hanging system.
- Exhibits need to adhere to the exhibition spaces available and hung on the tracking provided. No blutak is permitted on walls.
- Council (inclusive of staff, volunteers, and patrons) are not responsible for the artwork exhibited. Council is not liable for any lost, stolen, or damaged work.

### Works for Sale

- Contact needs to be made directly between the artist and the potential buyer. Council or library staff will not assist in the sales transactions.
- No commission or fees are required from the artis if exhibiting at Camden or Narellan Libraries.

## Bookings

- All works are displayed for a period of one month.
- Exhibits are planned well in advance. Bookings are made up to six months ahead and are ongoing.
- It may be in your interest to take a self-guided tour of our exhibition spaces prior to submitting your application.
- A specific day will be allocated for the delivery, installation and for taking down your art works. This will be within library opening hours.
- Please note, council reserves the right to change your booking dates with notification.

Council reserves the right to decline the work of any artist who does not meet these requirements. You will be notified via email or phone following the receipt and review of your artwork.
